CERTIFICATE.

do sincerely promise and swear that I will be faithful and bear true
allegiance to His Majesty King George V as lawful Sovereign of the United
Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and of the Dominion of Canada,
dependent on and belonging to the said Kingdom, and that I will defend
Him to the utmost of my power against all traitorous conspiracies, or
attempts whatsoever which shall be made against His Person Crown and
Dignity, and that I will do my utmost endeavor to disclose and make
known to His Majesty, His Heirs or Successors, all treasons or traitorous
conspiracies and attempts which I shall know to be against Him or any
of them; and all this I do swear without any equivocation, mental evasion
or secret reservation. So help me God.

That your Petitioner has duly taken the oaths of residence and allegiance as the whole will more fully appear by reference to the said oaths and the certificate of ADOLPH STARK, Merchant of the City and District of Montreal, an officer duly authorized to take oaths under the Naturalization Act herewith filed to form part hereof.

WHEREFORE your Petitioner prays that he be naturalized a British Subject, and that all the rights and capacities of a natural born British Subject be granted to him, and that a certificate of Naturalization, showing that your Petitioner has complied with all the requirements of law, be issued.

And your Petitioner as in duty bound will ever pray.
