That your Petitioner has duly taken the oaths of residence and allegiance as the whole will more fully appear by reference to the said oaths and the certificate of ADOLPH STARK, Merchant of the City and District of Montreal, an officer duly authorized to take oaths under the Naturalization Act herewith fyled to form part hereof.

WHEREFORE your Petitioner prays that he be naturalized a British Subject, and that all the rights and capacities of a natural born British Subject be granted to him, and that a certificate of Naturalization, showing that your Petitioner has complied with all the requirements of law, be issued.

And your Petitioner as in duty bound will ever pray.
